Hubba Hubba is a distinctive red Hubbard-type pumpkin (*Cucurbita maxima*) featuring elongated fruits weighing 1–2 kg. Its deep red skin and uniform shape make it an attractive ornamental variety, while its firm, orange flesh also lends itself to culinary applications. Medium-vigour vines produce reliable yields under UK conditions.
