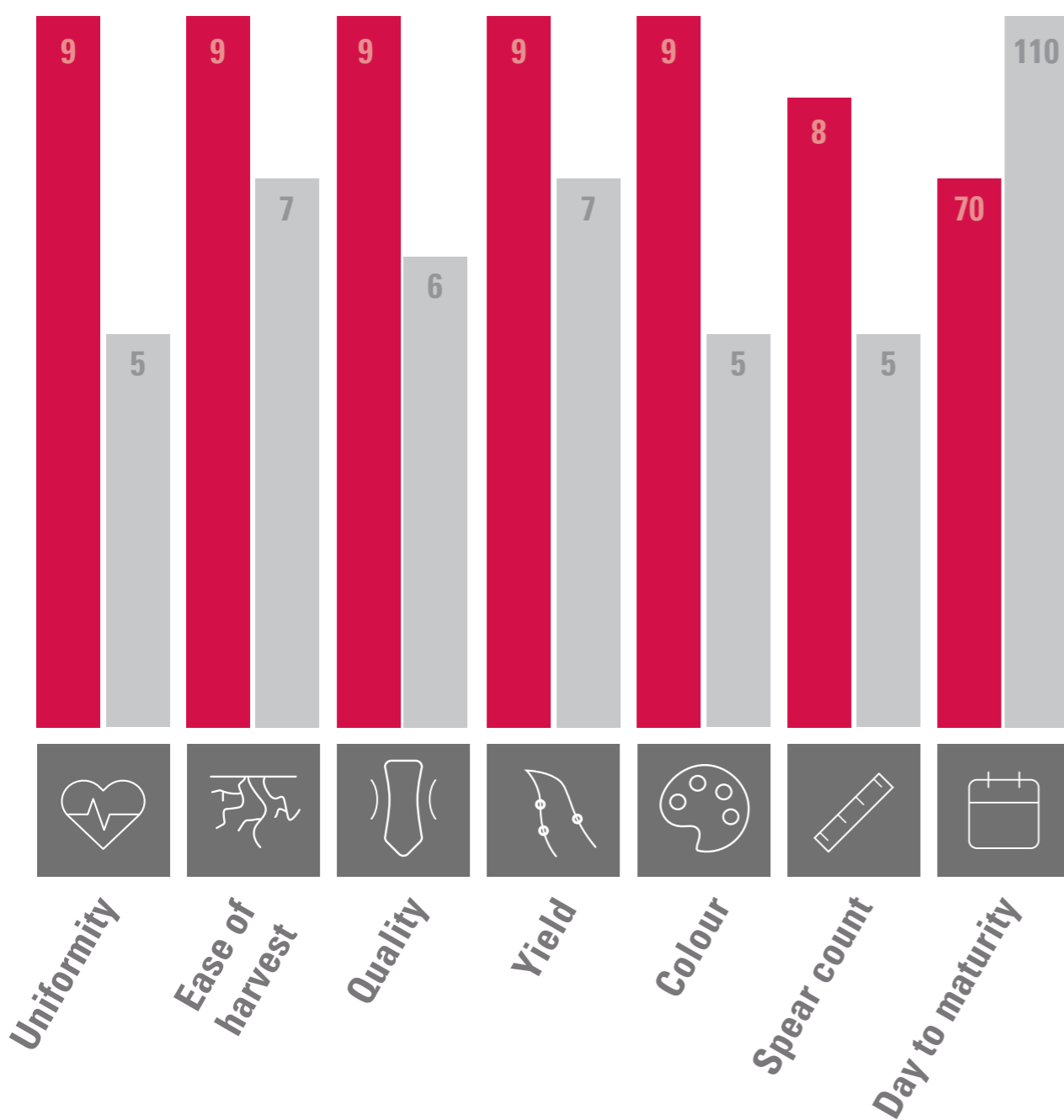

Description: Burgundy is a new and innovative PSB from the Elsoms breeding program. Proven to drive consumer demand, Burgundy is unbeatable in eating experience. A tender brassica with excellent taste, it produces high quality, fresh spears through a narrow harvest window. Vibrant purple in colour, Burgundy also offers an increase in yield potential compared with standard PSB varieties. Expect consistency and uniformity through the summer season.

Growing: Normal Spacing – 12TH/ Acre to be grown and treated the same as all broccoli. For additional fertiliser requirements, consult your regional growing guide. Harvest the outer side of the head first, allow for further growth and then pick the centre part of the head. Irrigation is beneficial to this crop as it increases consistency across harvesting throughout the year.
